News from UNESCO CHAIR in "Population, Migrations and Development"

- Production of updated scientific papers and reports: on the occasion of the International workshop on **"The Policy Use of Quantitative and Qualitative Indicators of Integration"**, organised by the IUSSP Scientific Panel on the Integration of migrants and the Institut National d'Etudes Démographiques (INED), the following research papers will be presented: **"A case study of multilevel governance on migration policies"** by Elena Ambrosetti, Eralba Cela and Annamaria Gravina; **"Measuring multiple social deprivation of migrants in Italy"** by Cristina Giudici and Cinzia Castagnaro. Paris, France, 25-26 May 2009.
- **Interim Workshops:** the Chair will organise two workshops with the aim to present the ongoing work and results; to analyse the situation of migration in the partner countries and how it can be addressed in light of the results of the Chair studies; to devise the appropriate methods and tools to address the issues concerning different contexts.
 - **Buenos Aires (Argentina):** the Chair organised a seminar in Buenos Aires in collaboration with Consorzio Interuniversitario Italiano per l'Argentina CUIA: on that occasion the Red Alvar and the UNESCO Chairs in "Population, Migrations and Development" and "Urban and Regional Planning for Sustainable Local Development" were presented. The event took place on the 22nd April 2009 and it was held by Raimondo Cagiano de Azevedo and Gianfranco Franz with the participation of Mrs. Margarita Poggi, Director IPE-UNESCO Regional Bureau Buenos Aires.
 - **Paris, CERI-Sciences Po:** on the occasion of the Unesco General Conference on Higher Education (5-10 July 2009), Catherine Withol de Wenden will be hosting at CERI-Sciences Po in Paris the next meeting of our Scientific Committee and a seminar on "Migrations and Development".
- **Network of the Unesco Chairs:** A representative of our chair was present at the **International Conference on "Migrants demand for the city"**, arranged by the UNESCO Chair in Social and Spatial Inclusion of International Migrants: Urban Policies and Practice, with some documents and illustrative materials on our current activities (Università Iuav di Venezia, 19-20 march 2009).
- Following the establishment of the Rome and the Paris Chapters, a **Brussels Chapter**, of researchers supporting the Chair, is planned to be activated too.
- The Unesco Chair has submitted a proposal entitled **'Migration and Development Experiences in Egypt: MaDE in Egypt'** within the EC-UN Joint Migration and Development Initiative (JMIDI). The results of the evaluation process will be published in early June.
