




- *Numerical* economic history

Mostly *Cliometrics*:

- Numerical economic history
- Statistical analysis of "large-scale" data
- Sources include:
  - Population censuses
  - Parish registers
  - Account books
  - Other public documents
- Extract statistics are used to answer important historical questions

# *Example*: when did England overtake Italy?

Italy was Europe's economic leader during the 16-17th century:

- England in the 18th century had the first Industrial Revolution
- So: *when* and *why* did England overtake Italy?
- Malanima (2011): 18th century because of over-use of resources
- Alfani (2013): 17th century because of epidemics







- Working days and wages paid


