#### Part VII - Research Activities

#### **Brief Description**

Egypt and North Africa: demographic transition. This research focuses on demography of the Mediterranean countries with special attention to the demographic transition in Egypt and in Norther African countries. In particular, the most recent researches on this topic deal with a) population policies

in Egypt, Tunisia and Iran (with Zahia Ouhadah Bedidi, Université Paris 7 and INED, France) b) the geography of fertility transition in Egypt (together with Yoann Doignon, CNRS, France) c) ideal family size among men and women in Egypt (together with Aurora Angeli and Marco Novelli, Bologna University).

International migration and integration. This research focuses on international migration, with special attention to migrants' integration, refugees' integration, migration policies and their effectiveness, migration and environment, immigrants well-being, perceptions of immigrants, social media and migration, sexual and reproductive health of female migrants, unaccompanied minors, Italian emigration. The research focuses on the Euro Mediterranean area with special attention to Italy. Several national and international collaboration were established over a 15 years' period for common projects, conferences and publications (e.g. with D. Bertel, M. Carammia, E. Cela, H.
